The performance is flexible and adaptable to different types of venues/spaces as it has already been performed in different reincarnations in a gallery, an empty shop, a working men's club and theatre stages of various sizes. Orientation is front-facing (proscenium) but can be adapted for black-box theatre and "thrust".

People on the road

2 + one technician/operator to be provided by the venue

Technical Requirements

LX: Basic/Minimal white wash. Unchanging throughout the show with one black-out at the end.

AV: Projector and Screen (or white wall) on back wall upstage

PA or other audio playback equipment to connect to laptop. Projection comes with built-in audio

All other amplified sounds are produced by the performers on stage, using portable amps and a wide range of microphones and piezos.

Other analogue sounds are produced by the performers on stage.

The show requires no sound engineer.

Transport

The company is responsible for transporting props, scenery and equipment on artists' own vehicle.

Parking space nearby required.

Timings

Get-in: at least 3 hours before show time

Unload and setting-up: 30-45 minutes depending on the number of helping hands available.

Rehearsal: 2 hours (1 tech rehearsal + 1 dress rehearsal with technician/operator present)

Show: 55 minutes

Strike: 30 minutes

Get-out

Company's requirements

Dressing room with running water. In the absence of a dressing room, a private room with a mirror where the performers can get changed. The performers can share one dressing room.

Available parking space for one vehicle.

Note: Some spillage of wine on the floor might occur during the performance.
